- 2) Research field and mission: The successful candidate is expected to play a role in the experimental study of fundamental physics using ultra cold neutrons and will work on TUCAN (TRIUMF Ultra Cold Advanced Neutron) project where commitment in search for the neutron electric dipole moment is expected.
- 3) Start of the term: As early as possible after official acceptance.
- 4) End of the term: March 31 in 2022
