## 11. Machine Tools

#### < General Information >

- (1) An RCNP machine tool should be set up in a metal working room and RI metal working room.
- (2) Students must be issued a "Permit for Student Shop Use" at the student shop.
- (3) Machine tools should only be used after fully understanding the hazards and proper operation of such equipment and the use of protective devices.

## The handling of machine tools

\*Please read the 'Manual of Use' carefully.

Name of Tool	Notes
Lathe	· Materials and bits should be firmly secured.
	After adjusting the chuck, remove the chuck wrench immediately.
	• Do not remove dust by hand.
	• A bit must be changed only after stopping the main shaft.
Milling Machine	<ul> <li>Materials and blades must be firmly secured.</li> </ul>
	• Dust must be removed by brush after stopping the main shaft.
Drill Press	· Chuking of a drill must always be done correctly.
	• Material must be firmly secured by vice.
	• Be careful at the beginning and the end of cutting.
	• Do not use army gloves
Contour Machine	· Be careful of your fingertips during foward adjustment of
	materials
Automatic Band Sawing	· Materials must be firmly secured.
Machine	<ul> <li>Confirm that the cutting oil is flowing properly.</li> </ul>
Grinder	· Confirm any irregularities in the grinding wheel before use
	• Do not stand in front of the grinding wheel when turning
	the power on.
	• Use only hardened materials.
	<ul> <li>Grinding materials such as aluminum and resin are prohibited.</li> </ul>

# **RI Metal Working Room**

#### 1. Purpose:

When you process activated substaces in the RI metal working room, please contact the radiation control room and follow their instructions.

#### 2. Workers:

(1) Workers must submit an 'Application for Entry to the RI Metal Working Room' to the radiation control room to gain entry.

- (2) The key to the RI metal working room is managed by the radiation control room.
- (3) Bear in mind the following points:
  - 1) A worker must wear the appropriate clothing and footwear.
  - 2) Please turn on the air conditioner before entering a room.
  - 3) Please wear a protective mask or goggles, if necessary.
  - 4) Do not wear gloves while operating machines except when instructed by the supervisor.
  - 5) When a radiation monitor is activated, a worker must promptly cease all work and contact the supervisor.
  - 6) In the case of damage to machinery, contact the supervisor promptly and follow his instructions.
  - (4) Inspection upon completion of work.
    - 1) The waste caused by experiments or any work should be placed into it's appointed container.
    - 2) The person doing the work must report to the supervisor immediately after the work is completed.
