Note on the HUA Master Thesis Award

- 1 This note defines the HUA Master Thesis Award. The Award is granted to the selected HUA members at a master's course (or corresponding course) of a graduate school, who have written a unique master's thesis on the activities at the Hadron Hall.
- 2 A candidate thesis shall be a master's thesis which has been written by a master course student with HUA membership, on a research related to the activities at the Hadron Hall. The thesis should be defended by the end of February of every one year.
- 3 In principle, the award shall be granted up to two candidate theses every year. If a good candidate doesn't exist, no award may be granted for the year.
- 4 The award shall be granted at the occasion of a HUA General Assembly. The award winners shall get an award certificate with a right to receive support from HUA to make print copies of his/her master thesis.
- 5 The following procedure shall be taken to select the award winners.
- 5.1 A candidate student shall submit three copies (or a PDF file) of his/her master's thesis with a one-page abstract written in English.
- 5.2 The selection committee shall consist of three or more members from HUA. The committee members shall be nominated by the Executive Committee, and appointed by the Chair. The committee shall deliberate on all the submitted papers and recommend award candidates to the Executive Committee along with the reasons for their recommendation.
- 5.3 The Executive Committee shall select award winning theses, based on the recommendation of the selection committee.
- 6 The Chair shall inform the selection result as soon as possible to the successful candidates and the HUA members.
