

Health Surveillance for Radiation Workers Required by Japanese Law

All items below are required. If any item is incomplete, you will be asked to submit it again.

1 Interview shall be conducted for the following matters:

- (a) whether the worker has ever received the exposure to radiation or not.
- (b) for a radiation worker with the history of exposure, place of work, contents of work, working period, radiation dose, occurrence of radiation hazards and other conditions of exposure to radiation.

2 Medical Inspection or medical examination shall be conducted for the following body portions and matters:

- (a) hemoglobin content or hematocrit value, erythrocyte count, leukocyte count and leukocyte percentage in peripheral blood;
- (b) skin;
- (c) Eye only when deemed necessary by a physician.

3 The result of health surveillance shall be recorded on the following matters:

- (a) date of health surveillance;
- (b) name of the subject;
- (c) name of the physician who conducted health surveillance;
- (d) result of health surveillance;
- (e) measures taken in accordance with the result of health surveillance.
