Description of the results in 100-200 words	An international workshop was held, co-organized by RCNP, CiDER, and the Grant-in-Aid for Transformative Research Areas (A), "Quantum Matter Science of the Universe Opened Up by Precise Numerical Calculations." The workshop focused on dynamical phenomena in quantum few-body systems, ranging from hadrons and nuclei to ultracold atoms, and brought together theoretical and experimental researchers from Japan and abroad. A total of 13 talks were presented, covering a wide range of fields including hadron, nuclear, and cold atom physics, all from the perspective of quantum few-body systems. Active discussions were held on recent developments in these areas. The workshop was attended by 20 participants, including 9 international participants, of whom 7 were affiliated with overseas research institutions. In addition, discussions were conducted on the application of computational methods developed in quantum few-body physics to the mathematical research carried out at CiDER, one of the co-organizing institutions.
