Description of the results in 100-200 words	The 9th International Symposium on Symmetries in Subatomic Physics (SSP2025) was held on schedule at the Nara Kasugano International Forum in Nara City, Nara. It aimed to deepen discussion and deepen researches related to symmetries in subatomic physics. Over 50 lectures were held, including poster sessions, on topics such as discrete and continuous symmetries in subatomic physics, symmetries in interactions, baryon and lepton number conservation, and flavor physics in general. It was a great success, with over 100 participants. The final day also saw a successful public lecture session featuring Professor Hidetoshi Katori (University of Tokyo), Professor Hiroshi Ooguri (Caltech, University of Tokyo), and Professor Naoto Saito (KEK).
